Specially tailored for our military students, this certificate is designed for maximum flexibility using a small Ultra-Mobile Personal Computer (UMPC) ACER as the primary device. This program is delivered fully online and is also self-contained on the UMPC ACER for those brief periods when Internet connectivity is not available.

The program incorporates the five Cs (Communication, Culture, Connections, Comparisons and Communities) set forth in Standards for Foreign Language Learning in the 21st Century, 2006, which is endorsed by the National Capital Language Resource Center and the American Association of Teachers of Arabic.

### Course Delivery Format - Taking the Course

This certificate is designed for maximum flexibility using a small UMPC as the primary device for the program. Students will need to log onto the internet weekly to complete practice sessions with the instructor and to submit major assignments. Students can complete course work without access to the Internet using the UMPC.



*The tuition fee is \$153.45 per semester hour; totaling \$614.16 per course.*

**Hardware and software used in the course include:** UMPC, eLearning Management System, Web Conferencing System, and Textbooks and associated DVDs.
