They can be burned to CD from a PC during the lending period (for personal use only; no other duplication/distribution of material is permitted under the terms of the license) and can be transferred to 1 portable device during the lending period. Copying of this file to personal device or to a CD for reasons other than personal use is not allowed. Collaborative play of this title is not allowed.</p>

FORMATS & COMPATABILITY: <p>Viewing of the NetLibrary eBooks requires a device with Web Browser access.</p> <p>Each NetLibrary eAudiobook is available in either protected WMA or MP3. Portable devices that can play protected WMA files can also play MP3 files. However, some portable devices that can play MP3 files cannot play protected WMA files. If you want to listen to any eAudiobook regardless of format, you need a portable device that can play protected WMA files and MP3 files.</p> <p>You can listen to eAudiobooks on a wide range of portable listening devices, including portable music players and portable media centers from Apple, Creative Labs, Samsung, Toshiba, and other manufacturers.</p> <p>To have an optimal experience when listening to an eAudiobook, it is recommended that you select devices that support features such as bookmarking and full time stamping and have a storage capacity of at least 1GB, since the average CD quality eAudiobook file size is 140 MB.</p> <p>Please note: not all devices will support all NetLibrary eAudiobook file formats.</p>

OverDrive MP3 titles are compatible with most MP3 players, including Apple devices. Microsoft® Zune® devices support OverDrive WMA and MP3 Audiobooks only. Your library or retail site may not presently carry all formats.
