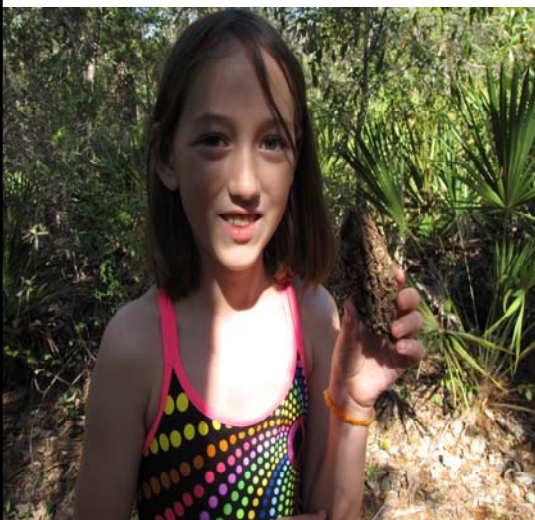

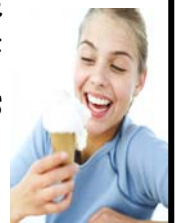


In house registration for Summer is 5-16 April. Slots will be open to the general public on April 26th.
