

2011 HURLBURT YOUTH CHEERLEADING REGISTRATION

Registration period is 8 July thru 19 August for players (**Deadline extended to complete team rosters**). Cost is \$20 per participant. All players must have a current sports physical on file at the youth center or have another one completed at registration time. Birth certificate or copy of DOD id card is also required. Tentative games start 3rd week of September. ONLINE REGISTRATION AVAILABLE.

WANTED: COACHES. We assign at least two coaches per team. Coaches may fill out a volunteer application at the youth center at any time; background checks and interviews included.

PARENTS: Will need to purchase Cheer outfit for their child.
